M25 junction 25 improvement scheme

Thank you for your patience during the recent weekend closures while we've been surfacing junction 25 on the M25 and its approaches, as part of our improvements.

We're not quite finished yet, and over the next few weeks we'll be finishing off our surfacing work, applying the final layer of the road surface – anti-skid surfacing, and testing out the new traffic signals on junction 25.

In order to do this safely, we'll need to put the following closures in place:

<p>Tuesday 19 April, Wednesday 20 April and Thursday 21 April 10pm to 5am each night</p> <p>Apply anti-skid surfacing</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • M25 clockwise entry slip • A10 southbound between Great Eastern Road and junction 25 • The northern section of the junction roundabout, between the A10 southbound approach towards J25 and the Holmesdale Tunnel exit slip
<p>10pm Friday 22 April to 5am Monday 25 April</p> <p>Lay new surfacing to the eastern side of the roundabout and install kerbing and drainage</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • M25 clockwise entry slip • A10 southbound between Great Eastern Road and junction 25 • The Holmesdale Tunnel exit slip • The northern and eastern sections of the junction roundabout, between the A10 southbound approach towards J25 and the A10 southbound towards Enfield



<p>Friday 6 May 11pm to 5am</p> <p>Saturday 7 May 10pm to 5am</p> <p>Testing of new traffic signals</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of the entire junction and all approach, exit and entry slip roads


Due to the type of work we are undertaking there will be noise, and we apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.
